Dear Parents,

As we begin a new academic year, I want to give you an update on our construction projects in the Bosworth Building and the townhouses. I'm happy to report that we have moved in to the townhouses at 124 Pierrepont Street. The new townhouse classrooms and studios are ready for classes this fall.

We initiated the most intensive phase of construction in the Bosworth Building last June.

Here's what lies ahead:

- Last phase of work will require us to take all spaces from the third floor down to the subcellar (offices, faculty dining room, student dining room, kitchen and classrooms) offline through January 2018.
- High school offices have moved temporarily to the townhouses for the fall semester. Most high school classes during the fall 2017 semester will be scheduled in the new townhouse classrooms and St. Ann's Parish House. Middle school classes will be scheduled primarily in the Bosworth Building (4th floor and above).
- Food service has been moved to temporary locations for grades 4-12. Middle and high school division heads will be sending additional information specific to each grade.
- The entrance has been moved temporarily to Clinton Street until the front entrance is completed.
- We will continue to use swing spaces at the Eastern Athletic Club, Brooklyn Heights Synagogue, St. Ann's Church Parish Hall and the Unitarian Chapel for some classes and food service.

This final phase is projected to conclude in January 2018. We decided to adopt a more aggressive phasing strategy in an effort to alleviate long-term inconvenience. As always, we will continue to take steps—working with our security staff, contractors and division heads—to ensure the safety of our students.
