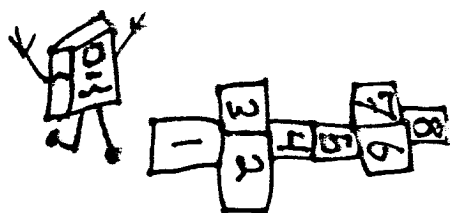
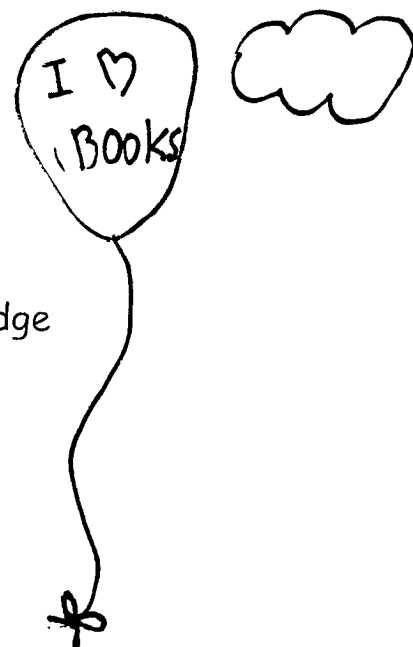
The Brooklyn Heights branch is temporarily at 109 Remsen Street, in a lovely (air-conditioned!) space, and they have lots of great events.
