

Sportsmanship Code For Spectators

Saint Ann's School and the athletic leagues in which we participate promote standards of fair play and ethical behavior. We encourage all student-athletes, coaches, parents and spectators to support teams and game personnel in a positive manner at all times. We ask that all spectators show support for everyone involved in the athletic competitions by cheering for their respective teams in a positive manner and by abiding by the following SPORTSMANSHIP CODE:

- I understand that the ultimate goal of interscholastic athletics is to provide an enjoyable and positive experience for all.
- I will be a positive role model by encouraging good sportsmanship.
- I will respect the game officials by refraining from addressing them or questioning their decisions.
- I will support the coaches by trusting their judgment and integrity. I will respect their decisions and encourage open communication by agreeing to speak with them only at a predetermined time and place, arranged by the appropriate division office.
- I will respect the rules of the venue of the athletic contest.
- I understand that I may be asked to leave the athletic contest if I do not adhere to the Sportsmanship Code.
