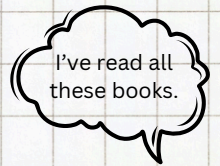

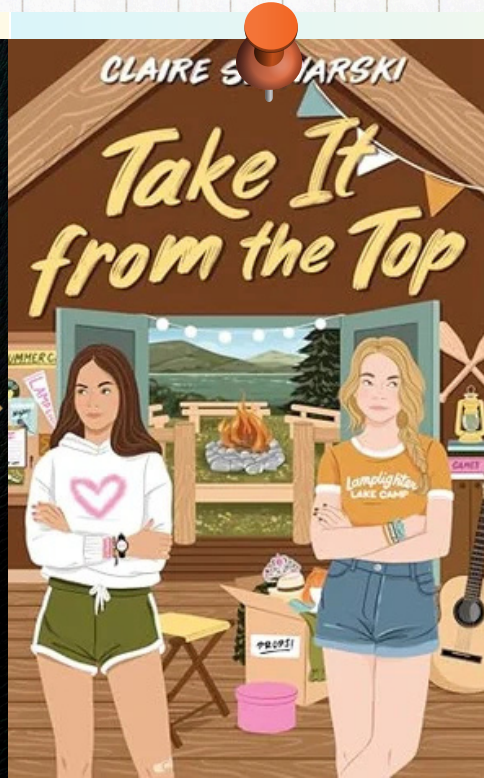
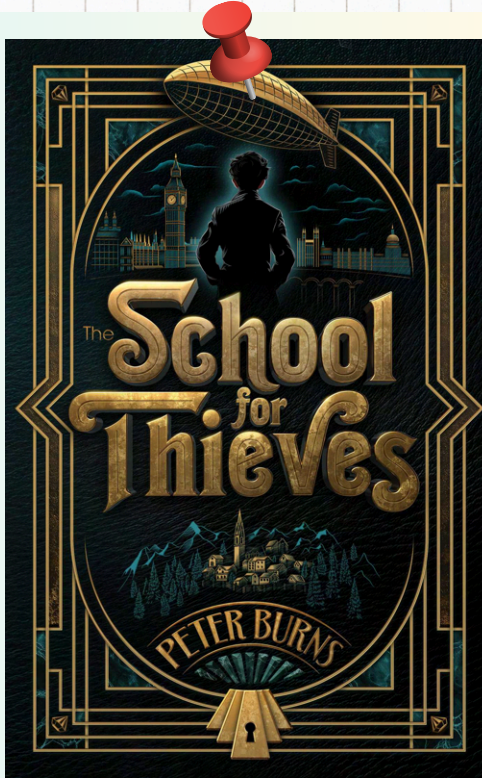

TRY ONE OF THESE!

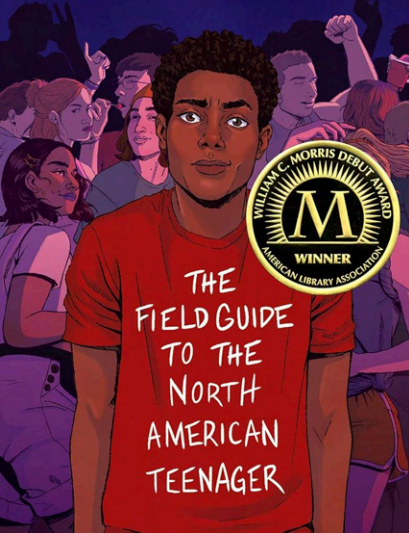

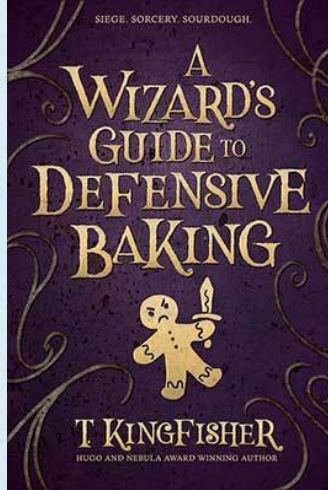


AN ABUNDANCE OF KATHERINES

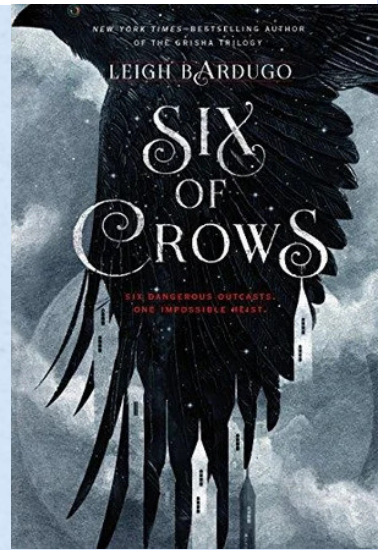

Trapped in a dark forest with his cold-hearted parents, Bonebag leads a cruel and isolated existence. However, he feels deep in his bones that things weren't always this way: he has known happiness before. Why does it feel like it was in a past life? When he discovers a locket that burns him to the touch, and a ghostly girl beckons him into the deep woods, he must grapple with the riddle of where he came from and how he came to be. 🎧📱

Recovering from a brush with a bully in the school bathroom, Zeke is shocked to see another boy stagger out of a stall naked and disoriented. Nice kid that he is, Zeke advises, "Dude, you have got to get some clothes on," and befriends the boy—who turns out to be Simon of Athens, who has spent the last 2,451 years in Hades serving Queen Persephone. After escaping on his 90,000th attempt, he's here in a Minnesota middle school and—read the book! Great for lovers of myths, adventure, and relatable characters. 📱

Fourteen-year-old Mona isn't like the wizards charged with defending the city. She can't control lightning or speak to water. Her familiar is a sourdough starter and her magic only works on bread. She has a comfortable life in her aunt's bakery making gingerbread men dance. But Mona's life is turned upside down when she finds a dead body on the bakery floor. An assassin is stalking the streets of Mona's city, preying on magic folk, and it appears that Mona is his next target. And in an embattled city suddenly bereft of wizards, the assassin may be the least of Mona's worries... 🎧📱

ROMANTASY

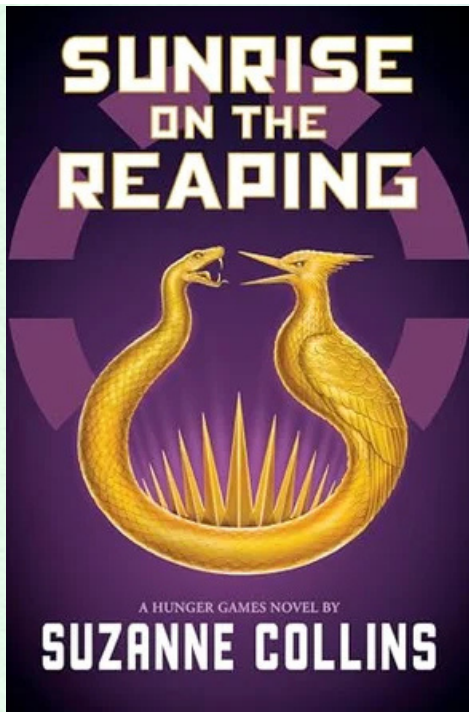

Epic romantasy inspired by *Beauty and the Beast!* 📱

A series from the author of *Shatter Me!* To all the world, Alizeh is a disposable servant, not the long-lost heir to an ancient Jinn kingdom forced to hide in plain sight. The crown prince, Kamran, has heard the prophecies foretelling the death of his king. But he could never have imagined that the servant girl with the strange eyes, the girl he can't put out of his mind, would one day soon uproot his kingdom—and the world. Clashing empires, forbidden romance, and a long-forgotten queen destined to save her people. 🎧📱

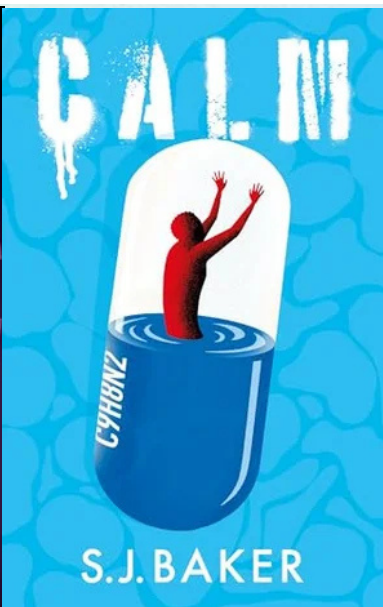

DYSTOPIAN



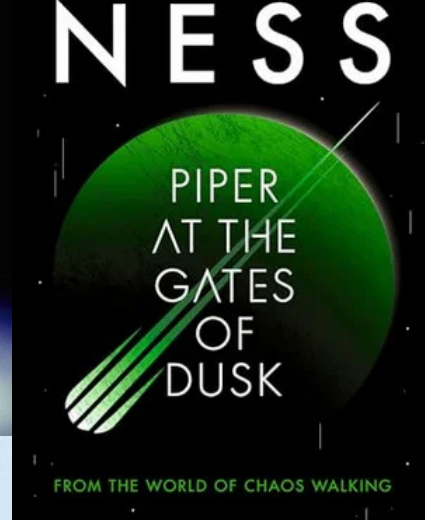

Devastation, rebellion, political intrigue, super satisfying tie-ins to the earlier books in the series. Read the other books in the series first, but definitely don't miss this one. 🎧📱



In a near-future Britain, calmadrug flows through the water supply, lulling people into apathy. Everyone is passive and emotionless, apart from a few Resistors (immune to the drug), and Abstainers (who choose to avoid it). New Resistor Owyn and lifelong Resistors Tiegan and Joel (siblings) face parallel struggles on the run, as they attempt to go unnoticed in an emotionless world and fight to change the system at the same time. *The Giver* meets *Unwind*. 📱

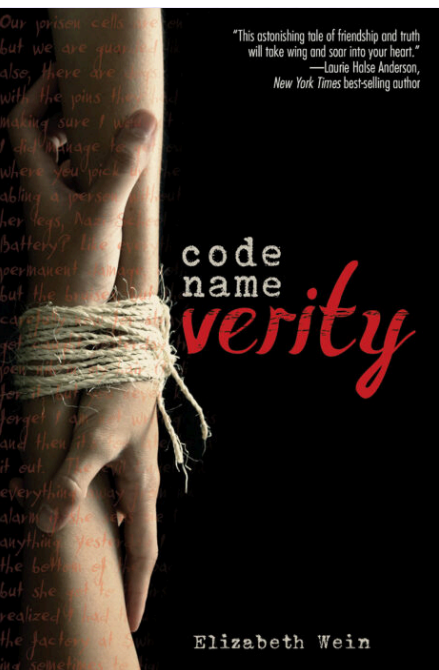


Cinder is a mechanic – and a cyborg – whose life becomes entwined with Prince Kai's as she becomes involved in an intergalactic battle. This is a cleverly imagined and completely unique take on a very old tale. Sequels: *Scarlet*, *Cress*, *Winter*. 📱



It's been twenty years since the monstrous war that almost tore New World apart. Ben and Max have known only peace growing up on the family farm outside a bustling human settlement. They dream of the usual things, like school and adventure... until a sudden sickness infects all young people with Noise, in the form of their worst thoughts about themselves. And then one by one, the children of New World begin to disappear. When Ben and Max get caught up in separate quests for answers, their journeys will test their beliefs in their parents, each other, and in their very existence on the planet. 📱

HISTORICAL

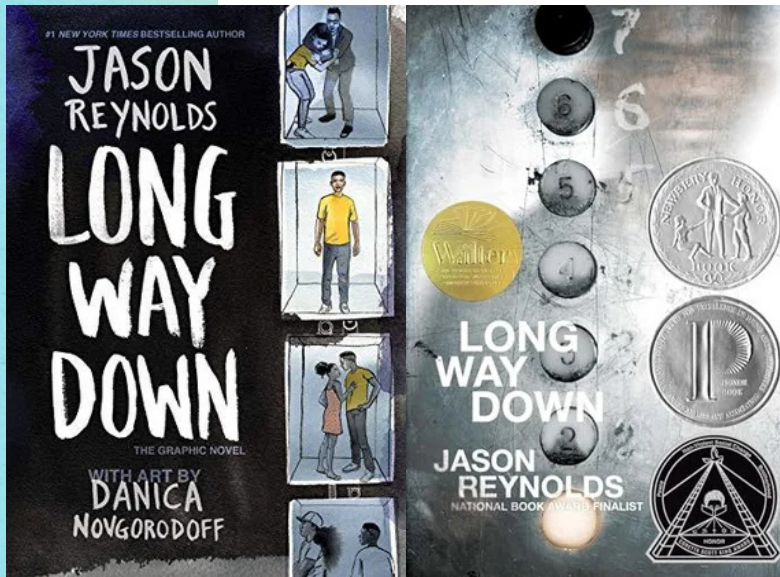


"Verity" is a secret agent, captured by the Gestapo and forced to write a confession. Hoping to buy herself more time, she describes her involvement in the resistance in great detail. But what is true and what isn't? Where is her pilot friend Maddie, and what else is happening while she sits in prison? A clever, dark, and thrilling read with a shocking end. 📱

Melati Ahmad looks like your typical movie-going, Beatles-obsessed sixteen-year-old in 1969 Kuala Lumpur—but she also believes that she harbors a djinn inside her, one who threatens her with horrific images of her mother's death unless she adheres to an elaborate ritual of counting and tapping to keep him satisfied. A trip to the movies after school turns into a nightmare when the city erupts into violent race riots between the Chinese and the Malay, and when gangsters come into the theater and hold movie-goers hostage, Mel must do everything she can to survive on her own and find her way back to her mother. 📱



BELOVED NOVELS GONE GRAPHIC



This novel-in-verse takes place in the span of one elevator ride—sixty potent seconds—the time it takes Will to decide whether or not he’s going to murder the guy who killed his brother. And so it goes, the whole long way down, as the elevator stops on each floor, and at each stop someone connected to his brother gets on to give Will a piece to a bigger story than the one he thinks he knows. 🎧📱



Whenever Lara Jean Song has a crush on a boy, she writes him a love letter – and hides all the letters in a box. But when they accidentally get mailed, Lara Jean’s love life is suddenly *quite* complicated. Fun, lighthearted romance—with sequels. 🎧📱

READ THEM BOTH!



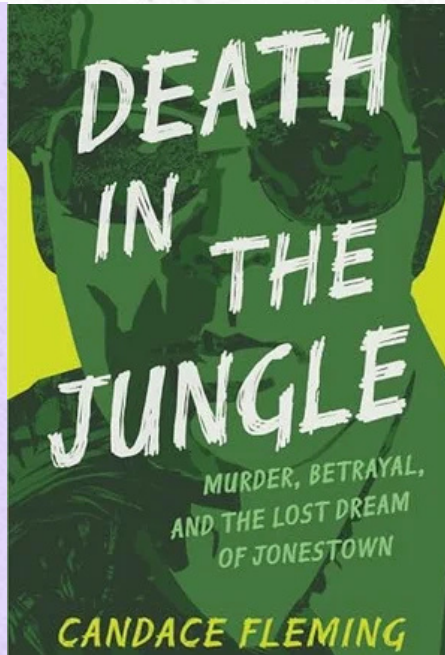
A graphic novel adaptation worthy of the original. Blue Sargent comes from a family of psychics—but she doesn’t have any clairvoyant abilities. That doesn’t stop her from joining Gansey, a rich student from the town’s all-boys private school, as they search for a long-forgotten Welsh king rumored to be sleeping beneath the mountains of their quiet Virginia town. Blue is thrilled to finally be a part of something full of magic. The Dream Thieves (book 2) comes out in August. 🎧📱



Katsa’s grace is killing. This is why her uncle, King Randa, keeps her at the castle and sends her out to do his bidding. But at 17, Katsa starts to question her uncle’s orders. When she meets Prince Po, a graced fighter, she begins to discover truths about herself, her grace, and her kingdom, as she sets out on a path toward justice... and maybe love. 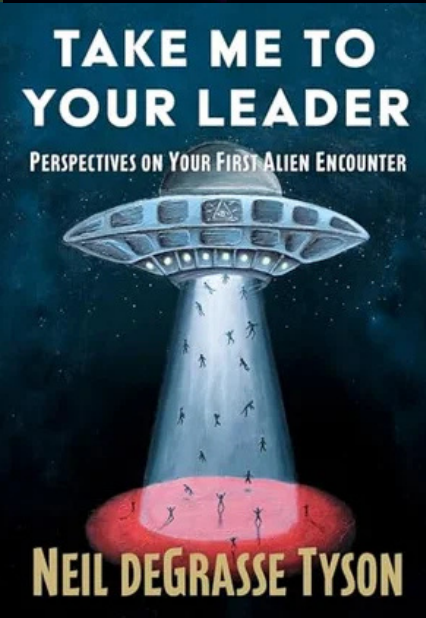
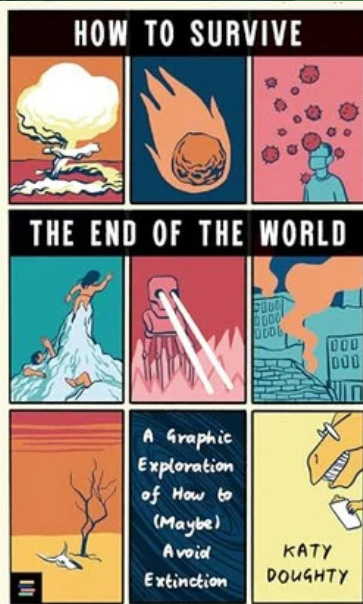
IT HAPPENED

GHOSTS

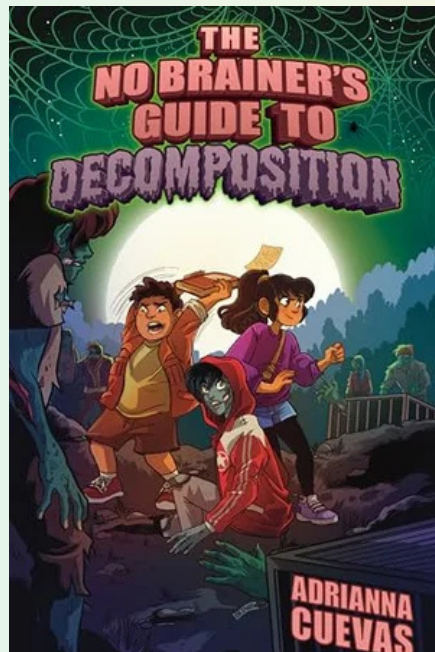

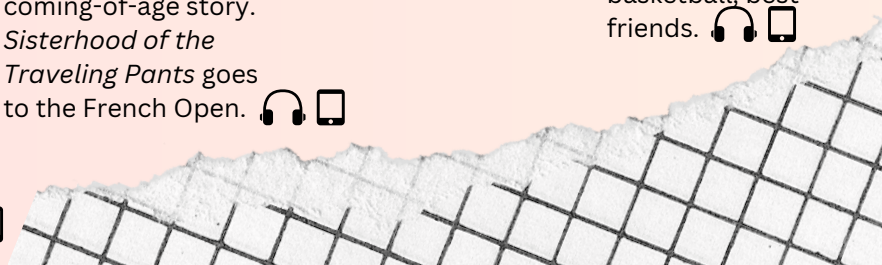
PLAY BALL

HOW TO USE THE DIGITAL LIBRARY

Access the Saint Ann's Digital library through Sora at <https://soraapp.com/library/saintannssny> or use the Sora app, which you can download from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.

Logging In: When you log onto Sora for the first time, you'll be prompted to find your school. If Saint Ann's doesn't pop up, search for it, then **log in with your Saint Ann's Google credentials**. Sora allows you to add other participating libraries, including the Brooklyn Public Library, so you can search multiple libraries at once and access their entire collection too.

Finding Books: To search for a title, click the "Explore" icon at the bottom of the page/app and a search bar will appear at the top. You can also browse lists and collections, including this list.

Checkouts & Returns: You can have four titles checked out at a time and the checkout period is four weeks. You may return books on the app or website. If you don't return a book yourself, it will automatically return. You can also download to a Kindle!
